HOW TO REGISTER A CAVEAT



The Applicant must have in his/her possession two sets of embossed caveat documents duly

witnessed by an Advocate signed by the person who is placing the caveat (Deponent) and dated;

Statutory Declaration signed by the Deponent & a Commissioner for Oaths and two (2) Passport

photographs of the person placing the Caveat.



The Applicant presents the full set of original documents and may provide a photocopy of the same documents, to the Ministry Zonal Office for processing. The intake clerk/receiving clerk intakes the document and provides an acknowledgement of receipt and or the Photocopy could be stamped 'Received', as an

acknowledgment of receipt and returned to the Applicant.



STEP 3

The Documents are then scanned and forwarded to the Registrar of Titles.

The scanning clerk scans in the caveat and sends it to the delivery clerk who makes a delivery receipt gives a copy of the approved to the client.

The Applicant checks with the Office of Titles after ten (5) working days to confirm entry of the caveat upon the register.



Upon approval the memorandum of registration is signed and title updated with caveat. It is then sent to the scanning clerk.

In case the caveat is reject/differed the reason there in is delivered to the client in letter form together with the submitted documents.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

- Caveat,
- Affidavit,
- Set of Passport photographs and
- General Receipts of Payment.

FEES PAID AT THE MINISTRY/DISTRICT

Stamp Duty 10,000/= and Registration fees 10,000/= If caveat affects more than 1 title 5,000/= is paid per extra title.
