





Protection of Illiterate Customary Land Owners and Requirements to include Women, **Minors, Absentee Persons and PWDs**



- 1. Any person instructed to write the name of the illiterate by way of signature to any document prior to the illiterate appending his or her mark that the document was read over and explained to the illiterate by that person must append his or her mark to the document and thereafter that person may write the name of the illiterate on the document and shall also write his or her own true and full name, provide a copy of NIN and address as a witness.
- 2. Women, minors absentee persons, Persons with disabillities and other groups of valuable persons are prefered by the law and must be included on the Cerificate of Customery Ownership (CCO's) as owners under the family land.
